## Role description

## Context

Scottish Queer International Film Festival (SQIFF) provides audiences in Scotland with an in-depth and inclusive opportunity to engage with LGBTQIA+ cinema and related art forms. Our priorities are a community focus and removal of barriers differing audiences face in accessing film culture. SQIFF 2019 takes place 2nd to 6th October in Glasgow.

## Purpose of role

The Volunteer Coordinator will work with the Festival Coordinator to plan and carry out a recruitment campaign for volunteers at SQIFF 2019, lead on volunteer training, and manage volunteers during the Festival.

## Responsibilities

- 1) Work with the Festival Coordinator and marketing team to plan and carry out an effective recruitment campaign for volunteers, ensuring the recruitment process is inclusive and reaches a wide range of LGBTQIA+ communities;
- 2) Act as a point of contact for any public queries during the volunteer recruitment campaign and for all volunteers once recruitment is completed;
- 3) Work with the Festival Coordinator to select volunteers to take part in the Festival from applications received;
- 4) Put together a volunteer schedule, working with the Festival team to ensure venues and events have enough volunteers;
- 5) Plan and deliver a training session for volunteers;
- 6) Manage volunteers during the Festival, ensuring shifts are covered, supporting volunteers to carry out their role, and giving priority to volunteer welfare, working with other team members as required;
- 7) Manage the Festival's Volunteer Travel Fund;
- 8) Plan and deliver evaluation of volunteers' experiences after the Festival;
- 9) Report on progress at Festival team meetings, feeding into the overall Festival planning process;
- 10) Contribute to post-festival debrief, providing constructive feedback and suggestions for improvement.
